



Choleric Buddha Lotus 8 x 6 ft Paper, Acrylic paint, spray paint and fire. 2022






Evening of healing Size: 3.75 x 3 ft Mixed Media: Paper and plastic Year: 2023






Heart Jewel 4 x 3 ft Mixed Media: Paper, acrylic paint, fabric and fire 2023






Green Piece 3 x 4 ft Acid free paper, watercolor ink with soap, acrylic paint, and fabric net. 2021









Astro I. 10 x 10ft Wood, acrylic paint, glue and plexy glass. 2022





Cipher to amuse height: 7 ft width: 5.5 ft depth: 3 ft Medium: Millar, wood, string and spray paint Date: 2021













Color Pencil Collection All works are: 5.7 x 8.2 inches Medium: Color pencil over acid-free paper. Each piece has its title and poem.








Universal compassion 84 x 69 x 48 in. Yarns and staples over wall 2019






Mind observing mind 60 x 60 x 48 inches Yarns and staples over wall 2019
